TALKING POINTS: WHAT CORAM DEO IS

Training others to live Coram Deo, which means to “live one’s entire life in the presence of God, under the authority of God, to the glory of God” can be a challenging thing to explain. Below are some talking points to help you articulate what the Coram Deo study is and what it offers to those who choose to embark on this transformational experience.

- A FREE 12-week online school of study with lessons and video teachings from Disciple Nations Alliance (DNA) leaders Darrow Miller, Bob Moffitt and Scott Allen.
- Discipleship material with the purpose of helping individuals integrate their faith into every aspect of their lives: at home, in the workplace ... in everything!
- A course that will help Christians understand and fulfill the unique role God has given them in advancing his kingdom of love, truth, goodness and beauty – in every aspect of society.

Coram Deo offers:

- A flexible format with the ability to study at your own pace or to study together with a group/class led by a course facilitator, called a Coram:Catalyst.
- An interactive experience with opportunities for online engagement, Facebook discussions and real-time interaction.
- A theoretical yet practical approach to understanding the role of the Church and your role, as a follower of Christ, to impact your culture.
- A relevant teaching. At a time when people are deeply concerned about where society is headed, we need to believe that the Church can make a difference in impacting our culture for good. That change starts with us, and Coram Deo shows you how.
- Opportunities for further involvement. Once the 12-week study is completed, there is an option to take a certification exam. Those who pass this can become Coram:Catalysts and lead others through the experience.
